On the 1st of July 2018 a group of youngsters of the Samantha community got together at the Samantha Hall, Palakkad. The initiative was suggested to be named as **Kerala Samantha Yuvajana Samiti**. A working Committee formed from among 30 members nominated President, Secretary, Treasurer and other working members.

The Samantha Samajam Central Committee was decided to be the parent committee of the youth wing and they were informed of the same. The aims and intentions of the new committee shall be same as that of the central committee.

The main aim of the newly formed committee shall be to collect and digitally record the details of all the people under the Samantha Community. Also the permission is being sought for an official inauguration of the Kerala Samantha Yuvajana Samiti on the eve of World Samantha Day (Birth anniversary of Appu Nedungadi 11.10.2018).

The presently formed committee shall continue for the duration of one year and the information collected in the mean time shall be utilised to include more youngsters and to expand the activities of the committee to a better level. The present committee plans to fulfil the above mentioned aims oi and intentions.

The Samantha Samajam took shape around 40 years ago with the pristine intention of bringing together the Thirumulpadu, Eradi, Nedungadi, Vellody, Kartha, and Pandalai communities. The present day Samantha Samajam is a superlative outcome of the cultural, artistic and social lives of our ancestors.

In an era of nuclear families and diminishing joint family system the Samantha Samajam offers inspiration to students, upcoming artists and growing personalities from all walks of life. It is in an attempt to add to its glory and to contribute new dimensions to the golden heritage that the Samantha Samajam Youth Wing has been formed.

The following shall be the aims, goals and duties of the Kerala Samantha Yuvajana Samiti:

- (1) In a drastically evolving and changing society convincing the present young generation about the importance of the existence of Samantha Samajam and to carry forward the rituals so that Samantha Samajam community regain its old glory.
- (2) "Today's youth are tomorrows' future." - Nelson Mandela. The committee intends to support and encourage the educational and professional aspirations, new upcoming ventures, skill development of the youth, making sure that both financial support and guidance reaches the deserving members.
- (3) To address grievances, sorrows and issues of isolated individuals of the Samantha Community, and offer help and support under the patronage of the Samajam.
- (4) To renovate and rebuild the familial ancestral homes and temples of the Samantha community and to maintain them against the decay of time and tide, and to maintain them as centres of cultural heritage.
- (5) To identify the financially backward members of our community and to offer them required help and support.
- (6) To ensure everybody's participation in the rituals and events concerning various individuals of the Samantha community. For example, participate in events organized by the Samajam, as well as visit homes and offer essential help to members on instance of demise of family members.
- (7) Organize small trips or get-togethers in order to awaken the organizational consciousness and unity amongst members of the community.
- (8) To offer complete support to the youth wings' efforts to gather information about all Samanthas. The information can be utilized in case of important life events like marriage, education, career etc. The website containing all the above mentioned information shall be a gateway to the future of the Samajam. Hence, members must consider it their duty to contribute towards this purpose.
- (9) To design a housing scheme for members residing outside Kerala and to equip it with a health centre, career guidance centre for children and a convention centre are the dream projects of the Samajam.
- (10) To join hands with other like-minded Hindu organizations and to work towards the progress of Samantha community and the society.

The Kerala Samantha Yuvajana Samithi is an organisation akin to the like-minded other Hindu Organisations and hence shall give due importance to activities that highlight Hindu rituals, culture and traditions. The venture is never complete/concluded, or never shall be... changes relevant to time and tide, and changing environment shall be always accepted and included.
